LOS ANGELES - LA Animal Services will announce a recent enforcement action at LAX that led to the confiscation of ten illegally imported Yorkie and Maltese puppies and City Council Member Tony Cardenas will introduce the puppies to the public to focus attention on the horrors of the world-wide "puppy mill" industry 10 a.m. Thursday, December 11, 2008, at LA's East Valley Animal Care Center located at 14409 Vanowen St, Van Nuys, CA.

Councilmember Tony Cardenas, Ed Boks and the LA County Department of Public Health will announce the results of a recent multi-agency animal cargo inspection program at LAX that uncovered dozens of illegally imported animals, including ten underage puppies from overseas puppy mills.
