NORTH CENTRAL ANIMAL CARE CENTER WINS AWARD

The Design Green award is a competition to honor projects that integrate exceptional design with new high performance standards for sustainability, LEED certified for their effectiveness while redefining architecture. The City's North Central Animal Care Center which is a certified LEED gold building, has also received:

- American Institute of Architects Design Award;
- "Best Green Building" award by California Construction Publications for McGraw Hill Companies;
- "Community Impact Award" from the Los Angeles Business Council; and
- "Exceptional Achievement Award" from the Southern California Development Forum.
