LA Animal Services Announces Another Generous Heigl Donation to assist New Hope Program Adoptions

Through their extraordinary efforts, they provide medical care, foster homes and ultimately a new family for so many deserving, homeless pets," stated Kathy Davis, Interim General Manager. The Heigl Foundation recently funded the Pits and Pals Spay Day at East Valley Animal Care Center, providing free sterilization surgeries to more than 100 dogs.
