Next Regular Meeting is scheduled for 9:00 A.M., November 12, 2019, at City Hall 200 North Spring Street, Room 1060, Los Angeles, CA 90012. (Enter on Main Street).

AGENDAS - The Board of Animal Services Commissioners (Board) meets regularly every second (2nd) and fourth (4th) Tuesday of each month at 9:00 A.M. Regular Meetings are held at City Hall, 200 North Spring Street, Room 1060, in Los Angeles, CA 90012. Evening Meetings are held in various locations throughout the City, from 7:00 to approximately 9:30 P.M. The agendas for Board meetings contain a brief general description of those items to be considered at the meetings. Board Agendas are available at the Department of Animal Services (Department), Administrative Division, 221 North Figueroa Street, 6th Floor, Suite 600, Los Angeles, CA 90012. Board Agendas may also be viewed on the 2nd floor Public Bulletin Board in City Hall East, 200 North Main Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012. Internet users may also access copies of present and prior agenda items, copies of the Board Calendar, MP-3 audio files of meetings as well as electronic copies of approved minutes on the Department's World Wide Web Home Page site at <http://www.laanimalservices.com/CommissionAgendas.htm>

Three (3) members of the Board constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. Some items on the Agenda may be approved without any discussion.

The Board Secretary will announce the items to be considered by the Board. The Board will hear the presentation on the topic and gather additional information from Department Staff. Once presentations have finished, the Board President will ask if any Board Member or member of the public wishes to speak on one or more of these items. Each speaker called before the Commission will have one (1) minute to express their comments and concerns on matters placed on the agenda. (For certain agenda items, speakers will have two (2) minutes.)

PUBLIC INPUT AT BOARD MEETINGS – Public Participation on Agenda Items. Members of the public will have an opportunity to address the Board on agenda items after the item is called and before the Board takes action on the

item, unless the opportunity for public participation on the item was previously provided to all interested members of the public at a public meeting of a Committee of the Board and the item has not substantially changed since the Committee heard the item. When speaking to an agenda item other than during Public Comment (see Public Comment below), the speaker shall limit his or her comments to the specific item under consideration (California Government Code, Section 54954.3).

Public Comment. The Board will provide an opportunity for public comment at every regular meeting of the Board. Members of the public may address the Board on any items within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Board as part of Public Comment.

Speaker Cards. Members of the public wishing to speak are to fill out one speaker card for each agenda item on which they wish to speak and present it to the Board secretary before the item is called.

Time Limit for Speakers. Speakers addressing the Board will be limited to one (1) minute of speaking time for each agenda item except during general public comment period which is limited to two (2) minutes per speaker. (For certain agenda items, speakers will have two (2) minutes each.). The Chairperson, with the approval of a majority of the Board, may for good cause extend any speaker's time by increments of up to one (1) minute.

Brown Act. These rules shall be interpreted in a manner that is consistent with the Ralph M. Brown Act, California Government Code Section § 54950 et seq.

STANDARDS OF CONDUCT. Speakers are expected to behave in an orderly manner and to refrain from personal attacks or use of profanity or language that may incite violence.

All persons present at Board meetings are expected to behave in an orderly manner and to refrain from disrupting the meeting, interfering with the rights of others to address the Board and/or interfering with the conduct of business by the Board.

In the event that any speaker does not comply with the foregoing requirements, or if a speaker does not address the specific item under consideration, the speaker may be ruled out of order, their speaking time forfeited and the Chairperson may call upon the next speaker.

The Board, by majority vote, may order the removal from the meeting of any speaker or audience member continuing to behave in a disruptive manner after being warned by the Chairperson regarding their behavior. Section 403 of the California Penal Code states as follows: "Every person who, without authority of law, willfully disturbs or breaks up any assembly or meeting that is not unlawful in its character, other than an assembly or meeting referred to in Section 302 of the Penal Code or Section 18340 of the Elections Code, is guilty of a misdemeanor."

VOTING AND DISPOSITION OF ITEMS – Most items require a majority vote of the entire membership of the Board (3 members). When debate on an item is completed, the Board President will instruct the Secretary to "call the roll". Every member present must vote for or against each item; abstentions are not permitted unless there is a Conflict of Interest for which the Board member is obliged to abstain from voting. The Secretary will announce the votes on each item. Any member of the Board may move to "reconsider" any vote on any item on the agenda, except to adjourn, suspend the Rules, or where an intervening event has deprived the Board of jurisdiction, providing that said member originally voted on the prevailing side of the item. The motion to "reconsider" shall only be in order once during the meeting, and once during the next regular meeting. The member requesting reconsideration shall identify for all members present the Agenda number and subject matter previously voted upon. A motion to reconsider is not debatable and shall require an affirmative vote of three members of the Board.

When the Board has failed by sufficient votes to approve or reject an item, and has not lost jurisdiction over the matter, or has not caused it to be continued beyond the next regular meeting, the issue is again placed on the next agenda for the following meeting for the purpose of allowing the Board to again vote on the matter.

4. ORAL REPORT OF THE GENERAL MANAGER

AGM Tammy Watson discussed the following:

- Issued the Notice to proceed with General Services to start the extension of the misting system throughout the training kennels and the play yard at the South Los Angeles Chesterfield Square Services Center
- Found Animals Gala was held this past Saturday
- Shelter at Home Program goes live today - it was passed by City Council and became effective October 8
- Executive Team attended the "Women Move LA" event last week – Commissioners Garcia and Finsten were also in attendance
- On September 28 South Los Angeles Chesterfield Square Animal Services Center and West L.A. Animal Services Center attended an adoption event at the Annenberg Pet Space and seven dogs were adopted at this event
- Benefits of microchipping – Sophia was reunited with her family after seven years because of microchipping
- Hired a new Public Information Director and hoping for a start date of October 28

AGM McLissa Webber discussed the following:

- L.A. Animal Services is participating in a study sponsored by the Annenberg Foundation in partnership with LMU to identify pet resources and services throughout Los Angeles County. This study is looking to identify all the resources available for institutions and pet owners to utilize and to be able to locate spay/neuter appointments and what the lead time will be. The hope is to identify opportunities to receive resources that many people seem to be without.

GM Brenda Barnette discussed the following:

- Captain Wendell Bowers from our East Valley Animal Services Center recently passed away – he retired last year. We do not have any information on his memorial services yet
- Public comment meeting for EIR Hearing was well attended. So now the consultants will go back and take the concerns of the people and will see if there are ways to make adjustments and still have the same quality to satisfy the Public Health Department and to some of the people that had concerns

- Annette Ramirez – Director of Field Operations is at PIMA learning about fostering adult dogs
- Safety in our shelters – working with staff to train volunteers to avoid accidents
- State-wide law now states that any bite history on an animal in the shelter **MUST** be disclosed to the new owner or rescue.
- Governor signed a law beginning in January there will be free pets to Veterans

Commission Gross – EIR Hearing was held last night for the new proposed Cat program. Over 200 people were in attendance and mostly supportive. Some people had issues with some of the restrictions in the EIR, but they had an opportunity to provide comments and the EIR process is moving along. Kapparot Situation – at 6:15 this morning I saw a long line outside of a poultry company on Virgil. I notified the Department because there have been incidents there where people have been purchasing the chickens and using them as weapons against protestors. Got a quick response from the Department that they were going to send ACO's to observe. Also received some information from Rabbi Klein about a situation in the Pico/Robertson area where staff responded to a situation there but could not access the house because they would not open the door. For the future, in terms of whether there is a suspected animal cruelty situation, how do we handle getting access to observe? How can we handle in the future?
