**AGENDAS** - The Board of Animal Services Commissioners (Board) meets regularly every second (2<sup>nd</sup>) and fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) Tuesday of each month at 9:30 A.M. For the duration of the COVID-19 emergency, the Board will meet telephonically and using Zoom software in conformity with the Governor's Executive Order N-29-20 (March 17, 2020). The agendas for Board meetings contain a brief general description of those items to be considered at the meetings. Board Agendas are available at the Department of Animal Services (Department), Administrative Division, 221 North Figueroa Street, 6<sup>th</sup> Floor, Suite 600, Los Angeles, CA 90012. Board Agendas may also be viewed on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor Public Bulletin Board in City Hall East, 200 North Main Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012. Internet users may also access copies of present and prior agenda items, copies of the Board Calendar, MP-3 audio files of meetings as well as electronic copies of approved minutes on the Department's World Wide Web Home Page site at <https://www.laanimalservices.com/about-us-2/commission/#three>

Three (3) members of the Board constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. Some items on the Agenda may be approved without any discussion.

The Board Secretary will announce the items to be considered by the Board. The Board will hear the presentation on the topic and gather additional information from Department Staff. Once presentations have finished, the Board President will ask if any Board Member or member of the public wishes to speak on one or more of these items. Each speaker called before the Commission will have one (1) minute to express their comments and concerns on matters placed on the agenda. (For certain agenda items, speakers will have two (2) minutes.)

**PUBLIC INPUT AT BOARD MEETINGS – Public Participation on Agenda Items.** Members of the public will have an opportunity to address the Board on agenda items after the item is called and before the Board takes action on the item, unless the opportunity for public participation on the item was previously provided to all interested members of the public at a public meeting of a Committee of the Board and the item has not substantially changed since the Committee heard the item. When speaking to an agenda item other than during Public Comment (see Public Comment below), the speaker shall limit his or her comments to the specific item under consideration (California Government Code, Section 54954.3).

**Public Comment.** The Board will provide an opportunity for public comment at every regular meeting of the Board. Members of the public may address the Board on any items within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Board as part of Public Comment. Each speaker will be granted a maximum of two minutes and the presiding officer reserves the ability to extend or limit the time depending on the circumstances of the meeting.

**Notice to Paid Representatives.** If you are compensated to monitor, attend, or speak at this meeting, City law may require you to register as a lobbyist and report your activity. **Time Limit for Speakers.** Speakers addressing the Board will be limited to one (1) minute of speaking time for each agenda item except during the general public comment period, which is limited to two (2) minutes per speaker (For certain agenda items, speakers will have two (2) minutes each).

**Brown Act.** These rules shall be interpreted in a manner that is consistent with the Ralph M. Brown Act, California Government Code Section § 54950 et seq.

**STANDARDS OF CONDUCT.** Speakers are expected to behave in an orderly manner and to refrain from personal attacks or use of profanity or language that may incite violence.

All persons present at Board meetings are expected to behave in an orderly manner and to refrain from disrupting the meeting, interfering with the rights of others to address the Board and/or interfering with the conduct of business by the Board.

In the event that any speaker does not comply with the foregoing requirements, or if a speaker does not address the specific item under consideration, the speaker may be ruled out of order, their speaking time forfeited and the Chairperson may call upon the next speaker.

The Board, by majority vote, may order the removal from the meeting of any speaker or audience member continuing to behave in a disruptive manner after being warned by the Chairperson regarding their behavior. Section 403 of the California Penal Code states as follows: "Every person who, without authority of law, willfully disturbs or breaks up any assembly or meeting that is not unlawful in its character, other than an assembly or meeting referred to in Section 302 of the Penal Code or Section 18340 of the Elections Code, is guilty of a misdemeanor."

**VOTING AND DISPOSITION OF ITEMS** – Most items require a majority vote of the entire membership of the Board (3 members). When debate on an item is completed, the Board President will instruct the Secretary to "call the roll". Every member present must vote for or against each item; abstentions are not permitted unless there is a Conflict of Interest for which the Board member is obliged to abstain from voting. The Secretary will announce the votes on each item. Any member of the Board may move to "reconsider" any vote on any item on the agenda, except to adjourn, suspend the Rules, or where an intervening event has deprived the Board of jurisdiction, providing that said member originally voted on the prevailing side of the item. The motion to "reconsider" shall only be in order once during the meeting, and once during the next regular meeting. The member requesting reconsideration shall identify for all members present the Agenda number and subject matter previously voted upon. A motion to reconsider is not debatable and shall require an affirmative vote of three members of the Board.

When the Board has failed by sufficient votes to approve or reject an item, and has not lost jurisdiction over the matter, or has not caused it to be continued beyond the next regular meeting, the issue is again placed on the next agenda for the following meeting for the purpose of allowing the Board to again vote on the matter.

Meeting called to order at 9:45 a.m. Commissioners present were Gross, García, Cohen, Finsten, and Sandoval. Also present from Los Angeles Animal Services (LAAS) was Interim General Manager (GM) Dana Brown, Assistant General Manager (AGM) Curtis Watts, Assistant General Manager Annette Ramirez, Board Secretary Francine Acuña, and Deputy City Attorney Steve Houchin.

**Commissioner Gross** opened the meeting, introduced staff, provided an overview of the meeting agenda, and provided instructions to the public on how to make public comments for this virtual meeting.

## **I. ADMINISTRATIVE APPEALS**

### **1. Dangerous Animal Case: DA 202114 WV**

Appellant: Kristi Dietz  
West Valley Animal Services Center: Lt. Julian  
Complaining Witness: Melinda Garber

The Board discussed the merits of the appeal, the evidence provided to the Hearing Examiner, and the grounds supporting the General Manager's determination. The Board found that the evidence supports the decision of the General Manager's determination.

**Commissioner Gross** made a motion to uphold the decision of the General Manager with modifications to the following terms: Term 1(b) to include that any dogs outside in the yard be supervised by a responsible individual and is with the dog(s) at all times; Term 4 to include a provision be expanded to allow for three dogs in the household, provided that the third dog is licensed and spayed or neutered; and based on the concern that the respondent does not want to have her privacy violated, Term 6 clearly states that a Department of Animal Services representative would only be inspecting the outside premises, to ensure the security of the fences and gates.

**Commissioner Cohen** seconded and the motion was approved by a vote of 5-0.

### 1. PUBLIC COMMENT

- **Michelle Cornelius** - stated the policy for listing animals on the orange alert list should be reconsidered and spoke about a high number of animals on the FAS list at the West Valley shelter.
- **Sherry Soon** - stated the spay/neuter ordinance should also include rabbits.
- **Sharon Brewer** - asked for the duties of the General Manager and suggested the General Manager's report be included in the agenda packet.
- **Carl Smith** - spoke about the municipal codes regarding guard dogs on business properties and suggested the municipal code be amended.
- **Michelle Kelly** - advocate for the spay/neuter ordinance to include rabbits and to recognize rabbits as pets.
- **Whitney Smith** - spoke about the problems with the appointment system and suggested the shelters be opened to the public.
- **Gail Raff** - asked for an update on the plans for the TNR community cat program and for an update on the money received from the State of California Food and Agriculture for the animal sterilization fund.

#### **4. ORAL REPORT OF THE GENERAL MANAGER**

**Interim GM Dana Brown** discussed the following:

- Spoke about the concerns over Pan Luke and how it can be prevented. West Valley dealt with a bad episode but is now under control.
- Reconstitution plans to reopen the shelters are due by the end of the month for implementation in August, assuming that the County continues at a green level.
- Fourth of July updates - public relations section posted daily updates prior to the Fourth of July weekend. Our partners were also fully engaged at the shelters providing support on reuniting found animals with their owners. 63 volunteers assisted with Community Assistance tables outside of each shelter. This year there were 146 dog intakes over the holiday weekend.
- Pet Food Pantry was held on July 11. There were 229 pets served at Chesterfield Square and 216 pets served at East Valley for a total of 445 pets served. The pet food pantry was not open on July 4.
- Staff reported that it is roughly a 50/50 split in regards to food bought versus donated food for the pet food pantries.
- The Department has a food contract with Newco which belongs to General Services Department (GSD). Negotiation and execution of that contract is under the jurisdiction of GSD. We will speak with GSD to ensure that we are getting the best price for the materials that we need.
- LAAS has been heavily involved in the recovery efforts for the citizens that were affected by the 27th street explosion that occurred on June 30. Field operations have been managing the citizens' requests and are supplying them with various types of animal essentials.
- All washing machines are currently operational with the exception of the West Los Angeles shelter. We are requesting approval today to purchase a new machine to replace it. The washing machine at West Valley has been repaired and is currently operational.
- Followed up on a caller's complaint about barking dogs at a business and stated the Department did respond to the business and confirmed that they do have a valid guard dog license.
- West Valley field operations responded to the Sepulveda Basin dog park and have not found anything to be inappropriate in terms of the usage. There are no pending investigations at this time.
- The Department is working on an automated app that will allow us to track data for appointments, no-shows, etc. We are looking to pilot the app at the East valley shelter later this month.

Public Comment was made by:

- **Veronica Christianson** - suggested the Department monitor the certifications of veterinarians to ensure they are qualified to spay/neuter rabbits.
- **Michelle Kelly** - stated there is only one clinic accepting the vouchers to spay/neuter rabbits and one other clinic but only neuters male rabbits.
- **Michelle Cornelius** - concerned about Pan Luke and stated staff should use proper hygiene and sanitizing of food dishes.
- **Whitney Smith** - recommended using disposable food bowls.
- **Sharon Brewer** - stated the dogs being dropped off at the Sepulveda Basin dog park were dropped off on Fridays.
- **Gail Raff** - stated staff is not aware of the proper protocols for Pan Luke and there are not enough veterinarians to spay/neuter rabbits.

- Report on cat litter being used at shelters to ensure it does not pose any type of threat to staff and volunteers.

- Requested a report back on the spay/neuter ordinance for rabbits and a list of the providers.
